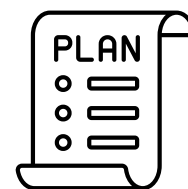
Building the resilience of your community improves its ability to prepare, withstand and recover from emergencies.

## How can the project benefit your community?



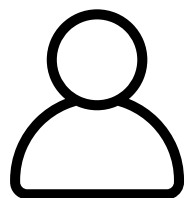
### Community Resilience Profile

Assistance with the creation or reviewing of the plan. Having a Community Emergency Plan can reduce the impact of an emergency.



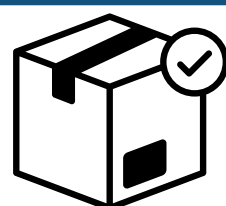
### Flood Warden Training and support
